The Students will:

Vocabulary

Form - 3D shapes

Illusion - something that is not what it seems to be/ something that tricks the eyes

Essential Question

Is it important to know how to draw for form? Why?

Lesson / Instruction / Narrative

Expectations: 1.Listen and follow directions. 2. Raise our hands to speak. How many people should be talking at one time? 3. Be Nice. How can we be nice? Review "class, class: yes, yes."

Warm-up: Review performing arts lesson. Review vocabulary.

Demo/Modeling: Students follow guided drawing for disco balls (2x).

Studio Time:

- 0- students get 2 circle papers and instructor passes out pencils
- 1- students follow guided drawing 2x (student leaders pass out glue sticks and sharpies)
- 2- students glue circles together and sharpie their disco ball lines
- 3- instructor passes out oil pastels and students color and design their disco balls
- 4- instructor passes out pipe cleaner handles and beads

Clean Up

Students return supplies and get ready for black light gallery.
