Lesson / Instruction / Narrative

Hello Most Amazing Artists!

Do art greeting

Sketchbook challenge: frog on the beach Pass out supplies while students draw

Introduce watercolor assignment

Have students write name and tape down paper

Do demonstration and....

Talk about foreground, middle ground, and back ground.

Ask students what skills from the last few lessons could be used in this art work? (shading, perspective, etc...)

Include any student answers in the demo.

Pass out supplies while students draw landscape

Discuss paintbrush care

Direct students to paint landscape using the skills they've learned this year

wander and work with any students who need help

give time updates

direct students for clean up

Remove tape for big reveal

Admission/Exit Tickets

Responses to questions posed at the beginning or end of a lesson or class to assess understanding of key concepts.
