Here is what the librarian looks at on the screen:

When ordering the librarian can gauge the age appropriateness of a book by looking at Interest Level: Kinder-3 (K-3), Grades 3-6 (3-6), Grades 5-8 (5-8), Young Adult (YA), Adult (AD) and Professional (PR).

Also, if it is an Accelerated Reader (AR) book they look at the AR Interest Level: Lower Grade K-3 (LG), Middle Grades 4-8 (MG) and Upper Grades 9-12 (UG)
